

What kind of bike should I bring?

Please bring your dual sport **plated** bike – this is an adventure ride, which means some of it will be on public roads.

What do I need to bring with me?

Be sure to pack your camping, sleeping and riding gear – including a Camelback and snacks (like granola bars), because you'll get hungry and thirsty as you ride. Extra gas//RotopaX is a good idea too. We'll provide your meals and the route. If you'd like to bring items such as a camera, navigation systems, or SPOT 2, please feel free to do so.

Parts of the route will be rough and you want to make sure your motorcycle is adequately protected.

What should I expect to do during the weekend?

Ride in Friday afternoon in the beautiful desert setting near Pahrump, Nevada, close to Jimmy Lewis's home. You'll be setting up camp at the [Wine Ridge RV Resort](#) where parking will be plenty. For RV spots or cottages, please [contact them directly](#) to reserve your own spots (not included in the registration). We'll provide you with dinnert along with the booze and the nighttime entertainment.

Wake up bright and early Saturday for a hearty breakfast, informative off-road seminar by Jeremy and Jimmy Lewis and a full day of epic riding with different GPS routes to cater towards each skill level. This year, our routes will be all along Jimmy Lewis's training grounds for Dakar in the remote off-road trails of Nevada. We'll meet for lunch at a special viewpoint and set back off to the epic adventures. You will need around 140 miles You'll come back to the campgrounds after your afternoon ride for dinner and the prize ceremony. The main attraction for the night will be the **entertaining presentation from Jimmy Lewis**, former Dakar podium holder and magazine editor. We'll also have other special guests who have competed in Dakar, to be announced later!

Leisurely wake up to a scrumptious Sunday breakfast and pack up your campsite with a pocketful of memories. Bid adieu to your new riding buddies and we'll provide you with scenic off-road/on-road routes and directions for your way home.

Can I show up day of the event, pay and get in?

Only those who have registered ahead of time and are on the list will be eligible to ride – this ride is capped. **You can sign up anytime on the website or by phone anytime up until February 21st at midnight.**

How do I sign up for this ride?

After you process and pay for your registration on our website and receive your confirmation email, you are on our list. If you choose to pay for registration for yourself and a friend, please put his or her name in Customer Notes as you process payment.

How do I get there?

A week and a half before the event, we will send out an email detailing a suggested route to the event, gpx routes, our meetup location, and contact information for the AltRider team.

Are pets allowed? Families?

Pets are not allowed. If your family members are registered and ready to ride, they're more than welcome to join us.

What is the camping situation like?

Everybody will set up their own tents on a space rented for AltRider. Don't worry, there are bathrooms and showers on the site this year.
