CAMPING SUPPLIES

- Tent –a footprint and rain fly are more than just a good idea
- Sleeping bag – IT MAY GET VERY COLD AT NIGHT, bring one rated +10° and lower
- Water (either water bottles or fill your CamelBak)—AltRider will provide some but it may be a good idea to bring your own too.
- Sleeping pad
- Flashlight and/or headlamp
- Stakes for tent
- Lighter and waterproof matches
- Multi-tool
- Comfortable camping chair

PERSONAL SUPPLIES

- CASH – Gold Point is cash only, closest ATM is 30 miles out
- Clothing for all kinds of conditions – rain, warm, cold – IT WILL GET VERY COLD AT NIGHT!
- Sunglasses
- Sun block
- Lip balm
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Towel and washcloth
- Soap
- Bug Spray
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Hat (if desired)
- Shoes (when not riding)
- Extra pairs of socks

RIDING SUPPLIES

- Street legal plated bike - portions of the ride will be on streets
- Insurance card
- Tool kit – better safe than sorry
- CamelBak or other bladder/hydration system
- Snacks for the ride
- Spare fasteners
- Loctite
- Spare tube
- Tire patch kit
- Tire lever (suggested: Motion Pro T6)
- Extra oil
- GPS unit (if desired)

OPTIONAL GEAR

- GoPro or other camera
- Still shot camera
- AltRider hard parts to protect in rough terrain
- Pivot Pegz for increased comfort while riding on the pegs
- Rotopax fuel packs – always a good idea to have extra gas on you
- Quick Steel Epoxy
- Quick Aluminum Epoxy
- Tubliss core
