

Itinerary for Conserve the Ride 2018

Friday June 8th

PRE-ARRIVAL

- Registration table opens at 2:30 PM. You may arrive before 2:30 and hang out, but please note staff will be setting up before hand and will not be able to check you in early.
- Remember to fill up your gas tank before your arrival! Rotopax and other gas cans are also recommended.
- GXP files will be emailed to you one week before the event.

2:30PM-5 PM – ARRIVAL: Meet at the Woodward Caves Campground

- It is **<u>REQUIRED</u>** to stop by the registration table to receive your welcome packets and sign your waivers.
- Claim your camping spots after you register and set up your camping area.
- Please have your GPS preloaded with the GPX files. These will be sent out the week of the event.

4:30 PM – **ALTRIDER OBSTACLE COURSE:** Test your skills

 We'll have our obstacle course set with various challenges to get you warned up for the weekend's adventures.

- 7:00 PM **DINNER:** Smoked-braised brisket and grilled cumin chicken and Roasted green chile black beans
 - Open Bar
 - Start getting to know people and picking groups for the big ride according to skill levels. Each group will have a group leader we recommend picking someone with great navigational skills, not just who the best rider is.
- 7:45 PM **FRIDAY RIDERS MEETING:** AltRider President Jeremy and Matt from SMCC will walk you through what to expect for the next day's ride.
 - **Designate your groups according to skill level and group leaders.** We will have signup sheets for each level of riding (scenic, intermediate, advanced) and you can sign up accordingly with groups of people or individually. 1 GPS device is needed per group.
- 8:30 PM **CAMPFIRE:** Gather by the campfire with a beer in hand for sing-a-longs and ghost stories.
- 10:00 PM- **QUIET TIME**: Tell jokes, drink beer, have some fun but don't make too much ruckus at this time.

 - The Saturday ride will be groups of riders following self-led GPS routes. **Know the**names of your group members and don't forget how many people are in your group!
- 8:45 AM **ADVENTURE RIDE:** Gear up and head out on your epic adventure in staggered groups.
 - Groups will be split up depending on skill level.
 - Staggered groups ride out every 5-10 minutes so we don't motorcade out in a dust storm.
 - Gas stops are scheduled if needed.
- 9:15 AM **SIDE STANDS UP:** Last group out for the 1st ride of the day.
- 12:00-1:15 PM LUNCH: Meeting spot will be at Union County Sportsmen's Club
 - Don't worry if you don't show up right at noon, lunch will be served until 1:15 pm.
- 12:30- 1:45 PM -MORE ADV RIDING: Leave for the 2nd half of your killer adventure ride
- 1:45 PM LAST RIDERS OUT FOR SECOND HALF OF DAY
- 5:00-6:00 PM LAST ARRIVALS BACK AT CAMPSITE
 - -Take this time to squeeze in a refreshing shower.
- 7:00 PM DINNER: Enjoy Thai red curry lamb w/ vegetables
 - -Beer and wine will be served and open bar
- 7:30 PM PRIZE CEREMONY AND AUCTION
- 9:00 PM **CAMPFIRE**: Kick back with a beer by the campfire and mingle with all your new friends.
